Current Affairs Of The Industry

Aiming to Strengthen Energy Requirements, India Set to Build New Strategic Oil Reserves

In a significant move aimed at boosting the country's energy preparedness, the Indian government is planning to build three new underground oil storage facilities. These strategic reserves will be located in Bikaner (Rajasthan), Mangalore (Karnataka), and Bina (Madhya Pradesh).

It is expected that these locations will be built in such a way that they will house around 9.3 million tonnes of crude oil. This is a big and smart move that will enhance India's ability to withstand global supply irregularities or price volatility. The best part about the said strategy is that it shall maintain supply in the locations which will be able to replenish oil requirements for nearly 90 days during an emergency. Of course, the strategy will be aligned with the International Energy Agency (IEA) guidelines.

This initiative will be overseen by Indian Strategic Petroleum Reserves Ltd. (ISPRL), a government-owned company responsible for managing India's energy storage infrastructure.

Sources say the augmentation of geopolitical tension and rising oil costs remain the main cause behind this strategic response. By increasing its stockpile, India aims to safeguard its economic interests and maintain fuel stability during times of crisis.

The strategic reserve project is part of the broader government push towards energy security and resilience, as the country remains heavily reliant on imported crude oil for over 85% of its needs.



India's First Vande Bharat Maintenance Depot Underway in Rajasthan's Jodhpur Division

- The location of the centre is highly strategic aiming to improve regional connectivity and create local employment opportunities.
- Once operational, it will significantly reduce downtime and maintenance travel, ensuring better utilization of the Vande Bharat rakes.

With Indian Railways aggressively expanding the Vande Bharat network across the country, this depot will play a critical role in sustaining future growth and maintaining world-class service standards.
