Defence Budget: A Tale of Two Realities

The Union Budget for FY2024-25, presented on July 23, allocated a record Rs 6,21,940.85 crore to the defence sector. This reflects a 4.79% increase over the previous year and constitutes 12.9% of the central government's total expenditure. On the surface, this appears to be a substantial commitment to national security. However, a closer examination reveals a stark reality: the defence budget is still grappling with a persistent shortfall.

The heart of the problem lies in the widening gap between the budgetary allocations and the actual requirements of the armed forces. While the government has made efforts to increase the defence budget over the years, it has consistently fallen short of meeting the projected needs. For instance, the fifteenth

Finance Commission's report revealed that the armed forces' requirement for revenue and capital expenditure for the five-year period 2021-26 exceeded the estimated allocation by a staggering Rs 15,24,100 crore.

This shortfall has far-reaching implications for national security. It hampers the modernization of the armed forces, impedes the acquisition of critical equipment and platforms, and compromises operational readiness. By adopting a realistic, transparent, and innovative approach to defence budgeting, the government can bridge the gap between aspirations and reality, ensuring that the armed forces have the resources they need to safeguard the nation.
